MINUTES

The Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Canadian Urological Association of June 21st, 1974, held at the Chateau Laurier in Ottawa, Ontario, were adopted on a motion by Dr. W.J. Staubtiz and seconded by Dr. S. Robinson. This motion was approved by the membership.

BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Dr. McAninch mentioned that Dr. James Ainslie had attended the Calgary meeting of the Canadian Medical Association as the representative from the Canadian Urological Association. It was indicated that this attendance was extremely important to represent our Association in the deliberations of the Canadian Medical Association. It was also mentioned that Dr. Graham of the Royal College had requested a list of names for the Nucleus Committee of the Royal College. A suitable list had been prepared by the Executive to be forwarded to Dr. Graham.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Expenses incurred were \$11,766.00 which were related to executive meetings, cost of the annual meeting, secretarial fees, printing, stationery and other supplies. The meeting is to commence on the evening of June 22nd with a welcoming reception. There are to be scientific sessions throughout June 23rd, 24th and 25th. On the Saturday, June 26th there will be two bus tours, one to Oxford and the other to Cambridge to visit the medical facilities at these institutions. Dr. Grant Farrow will be in charge of Local Arrangements for the Canadian group. Dr. Martin Barkin and Mr. Edwards of Manchester, England will be in charge of the Scientific Program. The topics to be considered are Paediatric Urology, Bladder Cancer and Urinary Calculi.
