At the annual meeting, a resolution was submitted by the Prize Essay Committee recommending that the Canadian Urological Association establish a prize essay contest open to residents and members in practice for five years or less. The subject of the essays may include clinical subjects or those related to clinical or basic investigation in any area related to the field of urology, and the prize essayist is to be invited to deliver his paper at the annual meeting. A cash prize is to be awarded and the expenses incurred by the essayist and his wife in attending the meeting will be paid by the Association. This resolution was approved by the membership and the first prize essay is to be presented at the 1968 annual meeting. Further details will be forwarded to the membership in the near future.

The 1968 meeting will be held at the Castle Harbour Hotel in Bermuda from June 19 to June 22. Doctor C. J. Robson, newly elected President of the Association, reviewed some aspects of the meeting.
