

At the annual business meeting, Doctor J. Charbonneau reported on the progress made toward changing the specialty examinations of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada to the multiple choice type. It is planned to have one-half of one paper ready by 1970 and ultimately all papers will be of the multiple choice variety. It was stated that some financial support on the part of the Canadian Urological Association might be required in the development of this type of examination and the membership approved in principle that the Canadian Urological Association support this development that the examination be so changed, and that an amount up to \$5000.00 could be spent, the exact amount to be determined by the Executive. The members approved a contribution to the House Furnishing Committee of the Canadian Medical Association equivalent to \$5.00 per member. It was decided that a specific gift be selected and presented in the name of the Canadian Urological Association.

Plans for next year's Annual Meeting are well under way. It is to be held in the Chateau Frontenac Hotel in Quebec City, June 21st to 24th, 1970. The setting and the dates should assure a large turnout. Local arrangements are under the Chairmanship of Doctor Arthur Bédard. Doctor W. E. Collins and his committee have assured us of an interesting scientific program. It is hoped that the program will be completed by January 1970 and any who have not as yet submitted their papers are urged to do so. Doctor Collins' address is:
