## Winnipeg Meeting Enjoyed by All

The return of the CUA to Winnipeg for our annual meeting after an absence of several decades was a great success. Our Past President, Ernie Ramsey and members of the Scientific Program Committee led by Larry Goldenberg, and all the members of the Local Arrangements Committee put a tremendous effort into this meeting. The quality of the scientific program was evident, from the excellent attendance and audience participation at all the sessions on all four days of the meeting. The social events at CUA meetings are traditionally enjoyable and well-attended events, and there was no exception in Winnipeg. The format for the President's Banquet was a little different from that in recent years, and the variation from tradition was well received. Commercial support and sponsorship was very strong this year, and it was evident from this meeting, that decisions regarding future venues for the CUA annual meeting will have to take into account the increasing demands for commercial exhibits at our meeting.

## Secretary & Treasurer Step Down

The June meeting of the Association marked the end of the five year terms of office for John Collins, the Secretary, and Bruce Piercy, the Treasurer of the Association. On behalf of the Association, I would like to acknowledge the tremendous effort they have made on behalf of the Association over the past five years. The excellent health which the Association enjoys today is in no small way due to the contributions which they have made.

## Annual Business Meeting Highlights

- Treasurer Bruce Piercy reported that the Association had a surplus of approximately \$153,000. Approximately \$60,000 was given to the Scholarship fund over the past year, representing \$10,000 from the Vancouver meeting, and \$50,000 from the Toronto meeting. Because of the excellent financial position of the Association, he recommended that the annual dues remain at \$135/year.
- Secretary John Collins reported that there were 14 persons applying for active membership, 10 persons transferring from active to senior membership, 2 resignations, and 1 death.
- In his Time and Place report, Dr. Collins indicated that Victoria had been selected for 1999 from June 20 - 24. This continues with the policy of rotating to central Canada every second year. The Time and Place report was approved unanimously.
- o Dr. Yves Fradet reported a change in the membership of the Research Committee on behalf of Dr. Belitsky. Dr. Morales was replaced by Dr. Curtis Nickel, and Dr. Michael Jewett was replaced by Dr. John Trachtenberg. Aims of the Research Committee were to improve it's capital base as there is concern about the withdrawal of funding from the Kidney Foundation. Awards were made this year to Dr. Martin Gleave, University of British Columbia, and Dr. F. Saad, University of Montreal.
- In his Training, Education and Evaluation report, Dr. Ramsey reported that Dr. Bernard Churchill had been replaced by Dr. Joseph Chin as a nucleus member of the Specialty Training Committee. The committee is required to develop a specialty specific FITER, and make recommendations regarding the content of a core program in urology training. Dr. Michael Chetner is the urology representative to the Principles of Surgery committee. Twenty of 25 candidates

- passed the Royal College Examinations in 1992.
- Dr. Michael Robinette presented the 1991 Economics and Manpower report, a copy of which is enclosed. There is an increase in the number of radical prostatectomics across the country. There was a marginal increase in urological incomes across the country. Dr. Robinette also presented the Maintenance of Competence report. Approximately 200 urologists have registered with the MOCOMP program. Excessive documentation has been a problem and it is hoped to have this modified in the future.
- Dr. Elhilali tabled a report on guidelines for use of transrectal ultrasound by urologists, and Dr. Morales submitted guidelines for laparoscopic procedures to be performed by urologists. Both were approved and are included with this newsletter.
- President Ernie Ramsey reported on the good health of the Association, and the various affiliate societies. The Urological Nurses Association of Canada may possibly join as an affiliate group in the near future. Dr. Ramsey also presented guidelines for case identification of prostate cancer. After much deliberation, the guidelines were approved. The position of the role of PSA in the management of prostate cancer was also discussed and approved. Both guidelines are included with this newsletter.
- Nominating Committee Elections

Drs. Brewer Auld, Luc Valiquette and Curtis Nickel were nominated and approved unanimously to be members-at-large for the nominating committee for 1993.

Awards Committee Elections

Drs. Malcolm McPhee and Said Awad were elected as members-at-large for the Awards Committee for 1993.


